

CENSUS


Collects data from the total set of items of the population from

Collects data from a representative sample of the population from whom information is sought.





- Services provided to people released from and adolescents undergoing treatment outside the center⁷
- Security, protection, and order
- Therapeutic justice
- Human rights protection



- Imprisoned women with specific needs within centers
- Pregnant or breastfeeding women
- With children under 6 years old
- Who have undergone abortions and/or experienced miscarriages
